Rust Kutter Directions for Use:















- 1. Select the surface to be treated
- Remove any loose rust using a wire brush or wire wheel. Rust must be present on surface for Rust Kutter to work. Do not grind to bare metal.
- 3. Shake Rust Kutter to insure proper mixing as some ingredients may have settled during shipment.
- 4. Spray Rust Kutter on the surface allow 24 hours to dry.
- 5. Rinse treated surface with water and allow to dry.
- 6. Brush off any loose residue.
- Select a quality paint suitable for metal surfaces. Priming is not necessary, but can be applied if desired.
- 8. Enjoy your newly painted surface for many years without the fear of rust returning.
