Directions For Use:

Apply one container of Emerald Green per acre of water 4-6 feet deep. One gallon will treat up to 1.5 million gallons of water, depending on water quality.

1 gallon treats 1 acre 4-6 feet deep 64 oz treats 1/2 acre 4-6 feet deep 32 oz treats 1/4 acre 4-6 feet deep

Apply either directly from container along shoreline or pour from slow moving boat. Emerald Green can also be applied at water inlet or by spot treatment at regular intervals across the surface of the water by hand held pressure sprayer. Use caution in windy conditions. Dve will slowly disperse and mix uniformly throughout the entire body of water over approximately a 24 hour period as a natural reaction to wind and water currents. Use additional dye if deeper color is desired. Note: Colorant is largely based on personal preference. Our dosing is a starting point and color should be added slowly in small increments until desired color is achieved. Every body of water will take a colorant differently. Existing pond dye can alter the color of Emerald Green. We advise users to test a sample from the body of water by adding a drop of dve to a glass of pond water to test the dve reaction to current pigments in water. When adding Emerald Green to city water expect dye to last for a shorter period of time due to the chlorine in city water.

Water Safety:

Safe and harmless to all animals and vegetation. Will not stain or harm water fowl, fish or livestock once diluted. **Precautions:** Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Do not ingest. Not intended for potable water. Wear rubber gloves and protective glasses to avoid stains from splashing. Not designated for use in swimming pools, product is not compatible with chlorine treated water or similar "bleaching" or purifying chemicals. Do not use this product in streams, rivers or other bodies of water not under control of the user.

Spill Clean Up:

Treat spills by soaking up as much of the product as possible using oil dry or absorbent cloths. Follow with bleach to prevent stains.

Storage and Disposal:

KEEP FROM FREEZING.

Do not reuse or rinse empty container. Dispose of container in a safe manner in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations. Do not use product inconsistent with labeling.
