Like hot tubs and spas, pool water can suffer from foaming, which occurs for several reasons. In addition to damaged or inefficient pool mechanisms, chemicals you use to treat your pool can result in foaming. Laundry detergent residue on swimsuits, body lotions and similar products can also cause unwanted bubbles. Ensuring that your pool is well-cleaned and functioning properly are two of the best ways to prevent pool foaming, as is the use of our pool defoamer when the first two fall short.

Some Common Causes of Pool Foam Are:

- Hair care products (shampoo, gel, mousse, hair spray, etc.)
- · Body lotions, deodorant & makeup
- · Laundry detergent or soap
- Cheap pool chemicals, too many chemicals, or total dissolved solids (TDS)
- Algaecide

How To Get Rid of Pool Foam for Good:

- I. If the foam is caused by algaecide, it will breakdown on its own. Just give it a few days to enter into the water all the way. You can skim the foam off the surface to help speed things up.
- 2. To get rid of foam, you need to make sure the chemicals in your water are properly balanced and at the correct levels with some test strips.
- 3. Check the pH and alkalinity and adjust them to the proper levels if needed (pH should be 7.4 7.6 and alkalinity should be between 100 150ppm).
- 4. A strict regimen of Pool Defoamer once or twice a week, depending on intensity of the foaming issue. **Directions:**

Pour 4 ounces directly into pool skimmer or intake

filter. Let our defoamer circulate throughout the pools system for 1 hour. If foaming still persists, repeat the process.
